

Update on the Chapel

We engaged Spencer R. Higgins, an architect certified in masonry conservation in heritage buildings. He and his firm have carried out projects across Ontario including The Armoury in Picton. Mr. Higgins visited Glenwood in early June and prepared an Initial Report and Recommendations.

An excerpt from the summary of the findings follows. "Given that the foundations (of the Chapel) are reasonably founded on rock at the southwest corner, and the other three corners of the building are settling, the walls are being distorted and have cracked. In addition, the east-end foundation wall is pulling away from the north and south walls due to slow subsoil and bedrock movement to the east. We are in agreement with the findings of the J.T. Donald report that the foundations must be stabilized in the long-run to minimize further deterioration of the masonry walls above. Unless a dramatic increase in the severity of the cracking at the east wall interface or floor slab occurs, we would suggest that there is time to carefully consider the options."

The cost of stabilizing the underpinnings of the building is estimated to be in the range of \$1,000,000 and the estimate for repairing the damage of the above ground structure is \$400,000 - \$500,000. The Board will be meeting this winter to review our options. A public meeting will be held in the spring for input. Thank you to our staff, Board and volunteers for their support.


